

Cabled Sheep

Espresso Scarf

designed by Cheryl Schumer

The traditional "Little Arrowhead Lace" pattern is alternated with seed stitch to create this easy lacy scarf.

Finished Measurements

Approximately 4" wide by 55" long

Materials

- ❖ **Yarn:** Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Aran (55% merino wool, 33% microfibre, 12% cashmere); color 300008; 2 skeins.
Or substitute approximately 200 yards of other Aran or heavy-worsted-weight yarn.
- ❖ **Knitting Needles:** 1 set US7 straight needles
- ❖ Yarn Needle



Gauge

Not critical. Approximately 19 sts = 4" in Lace Pattern

Abbreviations

- dbldec** double decrease: slip 2 stitches as if to knit, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knitted stitch
- k** knit
- k2tog** knit 2 stitches together
- p** purl
- RS** right side
- sl** slip
- st(s)** stitch(es)
- ssk** slip 2 stitches individually *as if to knit*, then knit the two stitches together.
- WS** wrong side
- yo** yarn over

Stitch Patterns and Techniques

Seed Stitch Pattern:

Every row: P1, *K1, P1, repeat from * to end of row

Lace Pattern:

Row 1 (RS): p1, k1, p1, [yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, p1, k1, p1] 2 times

Row 2: p1, k1, p7, k1, p7, k1, p1

Row 3: p1, k1, p1, [k1, yo, dbl dec, yo, k1, p1, k1, p1] 2 times

Row 4: repeat row 2

Pattern Instructions

Cast on 19 stitches.

Work 3 rows in Seed Stitch Pattern.

Begin lace pattern, following either stitch pattern directions or chart A.

Continue in lace pattern until desired length.

Work 3 rows in Seed Stitch Pattern.

Cast off, weave in ends.

 RS: knit stitch
 WS: purl stitch

yo
 RS: Yarn Over
 WS: Yarn Over

ssk
 RS: Slip one stitch as if to knit, Slip another stitch as if to knit. Insert left-hand needle into front of these 2 stitches and knit them together
 WS: Purl two stitches together in back loops, inserting needle from the left, behind and into the backs of the 2nd & 1st stitches in that order

k2tog
 RS: Knit two stitches together as one stitch
 WS: Purl 2 stitches together

Central Double Dec
 RS: Slip first and second stitches together as if to knit. Knit 1 stitch. Pass two slipped stitches over the knit stitch.
 WS: Slip first and second stitches together as if to purl through the back loop. Purl 1 stitch. Pass two slipped stitches over the purl stitch.
